

The school nurse/certified medication aide will have the following over-the-counter medication available at school to administer to students according to written protocol by the school and with parental authorization to administer the over-the-counter medication. A record of administration will be maintained by administering staff.

**Over the Counter Medication available at school:**

- **Acetaminophen (Tylenol) 325 mg/500 mg-** 1-2 tablets every 4 hours, headache, cold, sore throat, menstrual cramps, earache, etc
- **Children's Acetaminophen (Tylenol) chewables and liquid suspension-** as directed per age/weight of child
- **Ibuprofen 200mg tablets-** 1-2 tablets every 4-6 hours, headache, cold, sore throat, fever, cramps, pain, etc.
- **Children's Ibuprofen/Motrin chewable and liquid suspension-** as directed per age/weight of child
- **Antacid Tablets (calcium carbonate 500mg chewable tablets)-** 1-2 tablets, upset stomach, heartburn, acid indigestion, etc. (12 years and older)
- **Hydrocortisone Cream 1%-** insect bites, poison ivy, skin irritation-apply as directed
- **Antibiotic/Bacitracin Ointment-** minor cuts, scrapes, wounds, burns, etc.-apply as directed
- **Cough drops,** 1-2 cough drops -sore throat, cough, throat irritation
