# Common Application Scholarships: 1 Application applies to...

- Elma Tractor Pullers - involved in FFA/pursuing ag.-related degree - 2 available (\$500 each)
- Experimental Farm (taking ag classes for at least 1 year of college, write about your interest in agriculture and why you are interested in pursuing an agriculture career)
- Riceville FFA - available to those who have been an FFA officer, received an Iowa FFA degree, attended monthly meetings regularly, or have been involved in several FFA activities throughout HS
- Brooke Elliott Memorial - preference for nursing/medical student, needs 2 letters of recommendation (1 from a staff member @ Riceville, 1 from a non-family member)
  - \$1,000 - 1 available
- Kelsey Rickerl Memorial - pursuing career in medical, child-related, or education field
  - Additional essay question required: *“How would this scholarship specifically benefit you in your future career?”*
- Kendra O’Brien Memorial - pursuing career in nursing
  - \$1,000 - 1 available
- O’Brien Plumbing, Heating, & Cooling - pursuing career in HVAC, welding, trades, engineering, computers...
  - \$500 - 1 available
- Hendricks Memorial - pursuing career in law, medicine, business, teaching, or nursing
- Leona Schreiber Memorial - pursuing a career in education
- First Security Bank & Trust - 2 available (\$300 each)
- Hawf Scholarship (music) - sincere passion for and understanding of the importance of music
  - Additional essay question - *“How will music be a part of my life after high school?”*

- NEW!!! Norman Groth Family Memorial Scholarship - 8 available (\$500 each)
- Donor Scholarship - 2 available (\$1,000 each)

# Individual Application Scholarships: Each has their own application!

- Wa Tan Ye - \$400 - 1 available » **Due March 24** - open to all
- Grace Harkin Memorial - » **Due April 1** - open to all
- Mitchell Co. Cattlemen - \$750 - 3 available » **Due March 24**
  - *Requirements:* Interest in cattle industry, parent must be a 3-year member of the Association
- Mitchell Co. Environmental Education Foundation - \$500 » **Due April 3**
  - *Requirements:* Pursuing career in natural resources/outdoor-related field; preference to those who have attended programs/events by the foundation or Mitchell Co. Conservation Board
- Glenn VanSabben Memorial - \$ unknown » **Due April 15**
  - *Requirements:* pursuing career in welding/skilled trade - must plan to attend school in Iowa or Minnesota
- Pearl Hull Falk (MidwestOne Bank) - \$5,000 » **Due May 1**
  - *Requirements:* be of Protestant faith, resident of Iowa, attending *University of Iowa (Full-Time)*
- Ag Coop Safety Directors of Iowa - Up to \$3,000 » **Due April 28**
  - *Requirements:* pursuing career in ag. Or safety-related field + additional essay question: “*What does ag safety mean to you?*”
- Iowa Master Farm Homemakers Guild - \$500 » **Due April 1**
  - *Requirements:* For “**HS girl** who exhibits values of the organization, including education, life-long learning, and volunteerism”
- Riceville Student Council - \$200 - 1 available » **Due May 1**
  - *Requirements:* “Has been a friend to all, supported school activities, and has a positive spirit!”

## \*Buresh Scholarship\*

- Awarded to **all** seniors *who apply* and have good academic standing (good grades - HS & 1st Semester of College)
- MUST fill out application - COMPLETELY.
- Must file the FAFSA **OR** fill out a Financial Assistance Questionnaire (FAQ)
