

# 2023-2024 PK-12 SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

(These are supplies that will be needed to begin the school year. Please buy extra as your child will need to replenish his/her supply as it is used up).

\*\*\*If you are not able to provide your child's **required** school supplies, please contact the superintendent's office for resources available.



## PRESCHOOL

### Required

- 1 set of extra clothes (shirt, pants, underwear, socks)
- 1 school bag (needs to be able to fit a folder in it) (label with child's name)
- 2 pocket folders (label with child's name)
- 2 pocket folders with prongs (label with child's name)
- 1 spiral notebook single subject (label with child's name)
- 1 one- inch binder (label with child's name)
- 1 rest mat only for students staying full days (either a kinder rest mat or a yoga mat could be used) (label with child's name)
- \*\*\*Students may also bring a blanket with them for rest time. \*\*\*

### Optional supplies:

- 1 bottle of Elmer's White School Glue
- 1 watercolor paint set
- 1- 10 count box of markers (Crayola recommended and not skinny markers)
- 1 box of 24 count crayons
- 2 dry erase markers (not Crayola dry erase markers)
- 4 glue sticks
- 1 box of Kleenex
- 1- big container (75 ct.) of disinfecting wipes
- 1 box of snacks to share like crackers, granola bars, cereal, fruit snacks, etc.
- 1 box of ziploc bags any size (quart, gallon, or 2 gallon)

## KINDERGARTEN

### Required Supplies

- Medium sized bath towel for occasional rest time. No x-large sized or pillows, please (label with name)
- A regular sized backpack large enough to hold folders and books (label with name)
- Paint shirt-An old shirt or cover-up of any kind Please cut off sleeves at elbow length. (label with name)
- One regular size pencil box (label with name)
- Two-Three folders -bottom pockets (label with name)
- A large soft eraser (label with name)
- One box of 24 colors – regular size (Crayola recommended) It is a good idea to buy a second box to have for mid-way through the year
- An extra set of clothes just in case they get dirty

### Kindergarten Optional supplies:

- One blunt end pair of children's scissors(label with name)
- 2-3 dry erase markers
- 6 – 12 glue sticks
- One package of snack crackers or cereal (examples: Ritz, saltines, animal crackers, Cheerios, etc.)
- A box of Kleenex

- Washable markers for their own personal use (label with name)
